Question: What does this promise say about us?

(In light of the discouragement that comes into our lives from time to time)

Question: How does this verse positively affect you when you are feeling discouraged by mistakes?

Question: On whom must we remain focused during our times of trial?

Read Hebrews 12:2 (Read the verse)

Philippians 1:9-11 (Read the verses)

Question: What did Paul specifically pray for the Saints at Philippi?

Philippians 1:11 also (Galatians 5:22-23) (Read the verse)

Question: What are some examples of fruits of righteousness?

Question: What is the source of the fruits of righteousness/virtues of the Christian life?

Question: What is the purpose of having our love abound, approving the excellent things, being sincere and without offense, and being filled with the fruits of righteousness?

Question: In light of Paul's prayer request for the Philippian Christians, how does it compare to our prayers for each other?
