Philippians 2:1-11

**(Philippians 2:1): KEY WORDS:** *Comfort, Love, Fellowship*

**Question:** How does your relationship with Jesus bring you comfort?

**Question:** How does your relationship with Jesus enable you to comfort others?

**READ:** 2 Corinthians 1:3-5

**Question:** What does it mean to love unconditionally?

**READ:** Galatians 5:19-21

**Question:** What are the 3 types of love that were mentioned in this study?

1. \_\_\_\_\_ (friendship love) 2. \_\_\_\_\_ (sexual love)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ (unconditional love)

**(Philippians 2:2): KEY WORDS:** *Like-minded, Same Love, One Accord*

**Question:** What does it mean to be like-minded?

**Question:** What type of love should all believers share? Phileo, Eros, or Agape?

**Question:** What causes the members of the church to not be of one accord (united)?

**(Philippians 2:3): KEY PHRASES:** *Selfish Ambition, Lowliness of Mind, Esteem others better than yourself*

**Question:** How does selfish ambition ruin unity in the church?

**Question:** How does lowliness of mind promote unity and love?

**Question:** What are some examples of esteeming others better than yourself in a church context?

**READ:** Philippians 2:4

**(Philippians 2:5-8): KEY PHRASE:** *the mind of Christ*

**Question:** What does it mean to think the way Jesus would think?

**Question:** What are some things that we can lay aside in order to deem others better than ourselves, and have the mind of Christ?

**Question:** What does it mean to humble yourself? How can we be better at walking humbly before the Lord?

**Thought:** Lowliness of mind is not only having a humble opinion of yourself, but a deep sense of your moral littleness.

**READ:** 1 Peter 5:5

**Question:** To whom does God give grace?

**(Philippians 2:9-11): KEY PHRASES:** *Every knee should bow, Every tongue will confess,*

**Question:** Does *every knee should bow* refer only to the followers of Christ?

**Question:** Will non-Christians eventually be made to confess, (not to faith), that Jesus is God?

**READ:** Philippians 2:10-11

**Thought:** It is better to willfully commit your life to Christ in this life, than to unwillingly be made to submit it after it's too late.

**READ:** Philippians 2:5

**READ:** James 4:10
