HOUSE Groups: Discussion Questions:

Philippians 2:19-30

(Philippians 2:19): KEY PHRASE: *Trust in the Lord Jesus*

Question: Has there been a particular situation in your life where you have found it very difficult to trust in the Lord? Are you able to share about that?

Question: Are you currently dealing with something that requires your complete dependence upon Christ that we can pray for you about?

(Philippians 2:20-21): KEY PHRASES: *Sincerely care, seek their own*

Question: What are some practical ways we can show others that we sincerely care for them?

Question: What can we do as small groups that could help show our communities that we really care for them? (Jot down some ideas to be prayed upon, and possibly implemented)

Question: What are the marks of someone that isn't like minded with Jesus, and does not sincerely care for others? (v.21)

(Philippians 2:22): KEY WORDS: *proven character, served with me in the gospel*

Question: How is our character proven?

Question: Why is character so important for the Christian?

Question: Why is character that much more important for the Christian leader?

Note: Timothy had tremendous character, and he was recognized by the leadership (Paul) as a being a true servant for the Gospel.

Read: Mark 9:35

Read: Acts 6:3

(Philippians 2:23-30): KEY PHRASES: *fellow worker, fellow soldier, hold such men in esteem, for the work of Christ came close to death*

Question: How do you think it made Paul feel knowing that he had someone to help work with him?

Question: Paul uses the word soldier. What kind of things pop into your mind when you think of a soldier? Now take those things and apply them to your Christian walk.

Question: Why did Paul tell the Philippian church to hold Epaphroditus, and such men in high esteem?

Read: 1 Corinthians 15:58
