Jonah 1:4-5

(Memory Verse)

Jonah 4:2 NKJV - *2 ...I know that You [are] a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, One who relents from doing harm.*

(Jonah 1:4): But the LORD sent out a great wind on the sea, and there was a mighty tempest on the sea, so that the ship was about to be broken up.

Question: How do storms we encounter while in the midst of disobedience to God get our attention?

Question: How can God use storm/difficulties to get us back on the right track?
