**Question:** Why do you think that *love* was the first fruit of the Spirit working in the life of the believer mentioned?

**Question:** Describe the difference between joy, and happiness?

**Question:** Where does the world find peace?

**Question:** How does long-suffering play out in circumstances, and with people?

**Question:** Why is faithfulness such an important fruit of the Spirit in the life of the follower of Jesus?

**Question:** How is *gentleness* an attitude of the heart, and not mutually exclusive from strength?
