Daniel 6:1-28

(Key Verse)

Daniel 6:22 NKJV *"My God sent His angel and shut the lions' mouths, so that they have not hurt me, because I was found innocent before Him; and also, O king, I have done no wrong before you."*

(SECTION ONE)

Man Against Daniel

6:1-9

Question: Why do you think the other governors, and wisemen hated Daniel?

Question: How does a person living righteously threaten those that are evil?

Question: How should a personal relationship with Jesus distinguish a Christian from a non-Christian, and how should this difference affect the workplace?

READ: Matthew 5:16

Question: How does establishing a reputation of being faithful, and having an excellent work ethic bring glory to the Lord?

Question: Why was it that the enemies of Daniel decided to attack his faith?

Question: As our world grows more wicked... Why is living righteously considered wrong, and how should we conduct ourselves as Christians in spite of this?

(SECTION TWO)
Lions Against Daniel
6:10-15

Question: Why do you think that there are always going to be attacks coming against the person that is following Jesus?

READ: Psalm 22:13; 1 Peter 5:8

Question: Why is prayer so important, and how do we become powerful prayer warriors?

Question: How did the threat of being eaten by lions affect Daniel's decision to honor God by spending time in prayer?

Question: Why is it so important to be decided in advance, regardless of consequences, to honor God with your actions?

Who Can Be Against God?
6:16-28

Question: What work must the Lord have been doing in Darius' life when he proclaims that the *God whom Daniel serves continually* will deliver Daniel from the mouth of the lions?

Question: How did God save Daniel from the lions?

Question: What was the reason Daniel gave for God's decision to save him?

Question: As sinners how do we become innocent in the sight of God?

Question: When we are attacked for our faith, and when our relationship with God is tested what do we need to do?

READ: Romans 8:31
