Daniel 10:1-21

(Key Verse)

Daniel 10:18-19 NKJV *18 Then again, [the one] having the likeness of a man touched me and strengthened me. 19 And he said, "O man greatly beloved, fear not! Peace [be] to you; be strong, yes, be strong!" So when he spoke to me I was strengthened, and said, "Let my lord speak, for you have strengthened me."*

The Request **(Verses 1-10)**

Question: What practical challenges do you face when it comes to persevering in prayer?

Question: How does not understanding that God has appointed times for everything affect our relationship with Him, and how can that lack of knowledge be utilized by the enemy in his attacks against us?

Question: What is the definition of biblical fasting, and what takes place in the spiritual realm when a believer fasts and prays?

Question: Where in the New Testament is the seemingly parallel passage of Daniel 10:5-6 found?

Question: Have you ever had any type of interaction with an angelic being? If so, how did it make you feel?

Question: How can a Christian discern if something or someone is of the Lord, or of the enemy?

The Response & Resistance: (Verses 11-21)

Question: Why do you think that the enemy is allowed to bring resistance to the Christian's prayer life?

Question: When we pray we don't always receive an immediate answer from the Lord. How can silence from the Lord cause us to despair if not handled correctly?

Question: From Daniel chapter 10, who is the *Prince of Persia* referring to, and what do we know of spiritual rulers over regions?

Question: The vision that Daniel will receive from the Lord pertains to the _____ in the latter days. (verse 14)

Question: How does the Lord strengthen us when we wait upon Him, and persevere in prayer?
