(Key Verse)

Daniel 7:16 NKJV *“I came near to one of those who stood by, and asked him the truth of all this. So he told me and made known to me the interpretation of these things:”*

(SECTION ONE)

Vision of the Four Beasts

7:1-8

Question: Chapters 1 —6 describe the life, and times of Daniel. What are chapters 7 —12 descriptive of?

Question: What nations are represented by each beast?

Question: When you think of a kingdom, what kind of images come to mind?

Question: List the traits of our current world climate that would enable a global leader like the Antichrist.

Question: What do you know about the tribulation?

Question: How do you think the churches of this nation will be affected when members begin to be martyred for their belief in God?

Question: When God's kingdom is established, what are the things about our present world that you most look forward to being changed?

Question: What do you think "peace in the world" will feel like?

Question: Daniel's response to this prophecy was one of solemnity and sudden fright. What does Daniel's response tell you about him?
